Fortis has led the way in IBA processing and marketing for the last 10 years. During this time, we have recycled, processed and distributed over 1,000,000 tonnes of IBA Aggregate for use in the construction industry. In doing so, we have played an integral part in diverting over 4,000,000 tonnes of waste from landfill.

IBA Aggregate is a sustainable and cost effective alternative to Type 1, 6F4 and 6F5 capping and consists of fused clinker, ceramics, glass, stone and concrete. It has been widely used in construction for over 20 years and has been approved by the Environment Agency, Highways England and local authorities with great success. IBA Aggregate can be used in two major applications; unbound, it can be used for bulk fill and sub-bases. when bound, it is ideal for road paving and construction blocks.

Fortis IBA Aggregate affords the end user with many benefits compared to other materials, such as improved California bearing ratio and bulk densities, whilst maintaining workability and providing the environmental benefits of being locally sourced.
